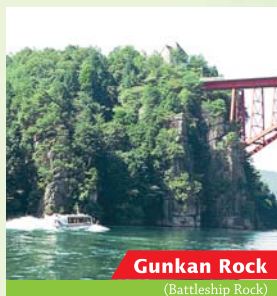

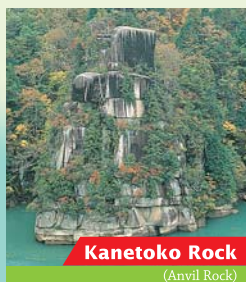
### Ena Gorge Guide

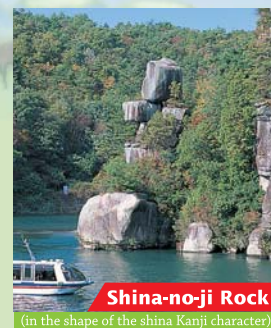
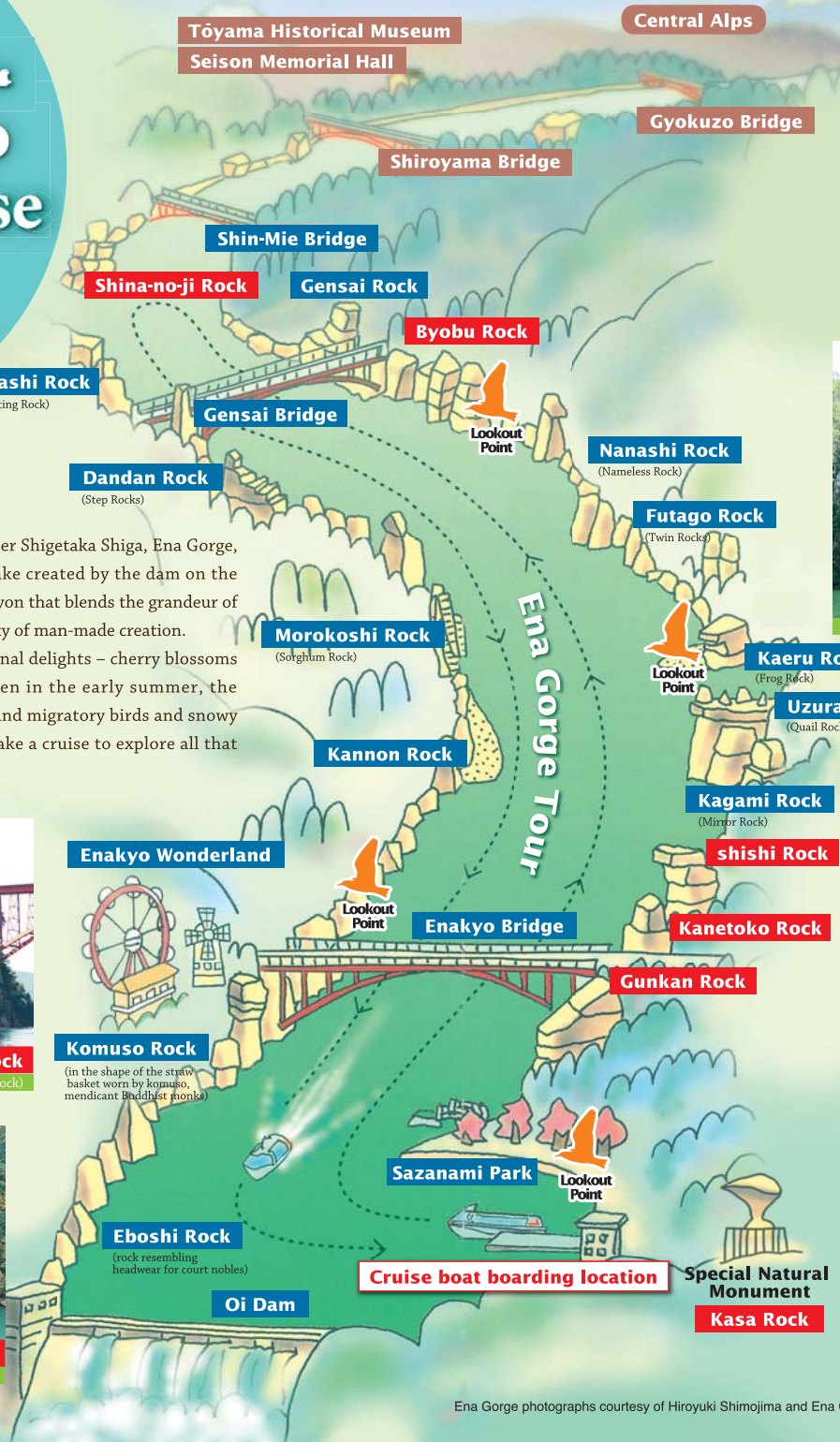

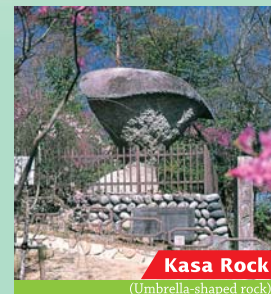
